

# **DIRECTOR'S NOTES**



William Shakespeare wrote: "To thine own self be true. And it must follow as the night, the day. Though cans't not then be false to any man." I believe this wise statement best applies to a woman. A blonde woman. For the past three years, she taught me, and showed us all, that being true to yourself never goes out of style. Ladies and gentlemen, your valedictorian, Elle Woods! - Vivienne Kensington

Although not a fan of the color pink, I am a fan of a good musical and was therefore intrigued with the idea of tackling this giant spectacle requiring

multiple locations, athletic choreography, 20 songs, 31 cast members, and two dogs. And now, after hundreds of hours spent doing research, attending meetings, and rehearsing this show, I have discovered that Elle Woods is my hero. A true humanitarian, she is the epitome of integrity, strength, and positivity and, though many may judge a book by its cover, she subverts expectations while remaining true to herself. Based on Amanda Brown's 2001 novel and the movie of the same name that is said to have inspired a generation of women to attend law school, the musical version of Legally Blonde stays faithful to the source material while following a female protagonist on a journey of sisterhood, self-discovery, and eventually, self-love.

In a time when many shows on Broadway are uninspired adaptations of movies, this show, in my opinion, easily and successfully translates to the stage due to its catchy songs, clever book, inspiring characters, and poignant message. Tackling issues and scandals predating yet redolent of the #MeToo Movement, this seemingly fluffy story is so much more than it seems. Driven by a woman who fights for justice despite obstacles to which many of us can relate, Legally Blonde empowers us to defy expectations, pursue our wildest dreams, and most importantly, remain true to ourselves. So, despite my distaste for the color pink, this gem of a show, replete with sharp humor and some damn fine quotes, is now one of my favorite musicals.





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
